The Week at St Michael's

The musical setting will be by Merbecke in future in Lent and Advent and, unless otherwise stated the preacher will be the Rector. The Creed will be said every week except on major festivals.

Monday, 1.00 pm Organ Recital (except in August and on Bank Holidays). This series of recitals was started by Harold Darke in 1916.

Wednesday, 1.10 pm Holy Communion (said) (lasts twenty-five minutes), with two minute sermon on fundamental Christian teaching.

Friday, 1.10 pm Holy Communion (said).

Sometimes at our Wednesday and Friday Services we celebrate the Latin Tridentine Mass – commonly known as ‘the old Mass’. If you would like to know when this Mass will be celebrated, please contact the Rector.

Our choir is renowned throughout the City and beyond and we are regarded for the beauty and dignity of our Marriage Services, Livery Company Services and Memorial Services.

Christenings take place during our main Service (always a splendid choral setting) on Sundays at 11.00 am.
