The Monday lunchtime recitals at St Michael's first became a fixture in the life of the City of London in 1914, when office workers turned to the Church for comfort from the horrors of World War I. Some of the 3,500 pipes of the organ date back to 1684, when the opening recital was given by Henry Purcell. The latest restoration was by Nicholsons in 2010. Organists of the church have included the composers William Boyce and Harold Darke. The (Royal) College of Organists was founded here in 1864.
